The Duart Appeal

The Restoration of Duart Castle continues and is now raising funds to commit £175,000 to a Phase 7 of reduced scale costing up to £290,000 and finished by April 2021. Historic Environment Scotland (HES) will be approached for support to mainly repair the walkway and the remaining walls over Phases 8, 9 & 10.

As of the last update, the Appeal has achieved a gross total of £692,659. Clan Maclean Association in the United States has raised **£4,006** in its own right and **£452,288** from its geographic area which includes £315,803 from Chief's Circle Donors.
